Subject: Officiating Allowance

The Ministry of Finance hereby notifies that the Officiating Allowance as prescribed in Clause No.6.2.4 of Chapter 11 of the Bhutan Civil Service Rules and Regulations 2010 has been approved by the Royal Government. The Officiating Allowance is payable for officiating positions in P1 (without sub-levels) and above managerial positions and heads of institutes for a duration above one month but not exceeding six months. The Officiating Allowance rate will be the difference between the incumbent's current salary and the salary of the position he/she is assigned to officiate.

The Officiating Allowance will come into effect from 1st July, 2011.

The above is issued as per the decision of the 100th Session of the Lhengye Zhungtshog held on 17th May, 2011.
