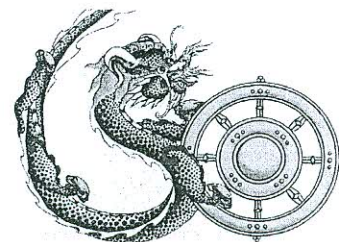

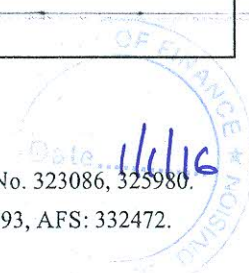

Therefore, interested and eligible in-service candidates are encouraged to apply for the above scholarship.

Benefits of Scholarship

The successful candidates shall receive following benefits during training:

1. Monthly Stipend: Nu. 50,000;
2. Book allowance (*annually*): Nu. 12,500;
3. One time establishment allowance: Nu. 10,000;
4. Research grants with DSA of Nu. 350 per day for the duration of two months (*for Master's Degree*);
5. To & fro air fare (*only once*);
6. Coverage of health insurance; and
7. Tuition Fees.

Eligibility

Besides fulfilling those criteria prescribed in BCSR 2012, the applicants must also fulfill the following criteria in order to apply for the above scholarship:

1. Must have minimum of 55% in Degree; and
2. Should be BCSE-Select.

Application Documents Required

1. For areas 1, 2(i) & 4:

- a. Duly filled In-Service Training Form (*Annexure 9/3 of BCSR 2012*);
- b. A copy of Academic Transcript and Pass Certificate of Bachelor's Degree and PG Diploma each;
- c. Recommendation Letter or Statement from the School Principal stating that he/she is currently teaching the chosen course in CI-XI or XII in case of Teachers applying for courses such as Economics, Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics; and
- d. A copy of updated (*accurate*) CV in the CSIS.

2. For area 2(ii) & 3:

- a. Duly filled In-Service Training Form (*Annexure 9/3 of BCSR 2012*);
- b. A copy of Academic Transcript and Pass Certificate of Bachelor's Degree; and
- c. A copy of updated (*accurate*) CV in the CSIS.

Note:

All the applicants are requested to kindly mention the year in which you have appeared the Bhutan Civil Service Examination (*BCSE*) on the first page of In-Service Training Form.

Application Procedure and Deadline

The application documents must be submitted to:

1. Respective Ministries/Agencies on or before **22nd January, 2016**; and
2. Ministries/Agencies to the RCSC on or before **26th January, 2016**.
