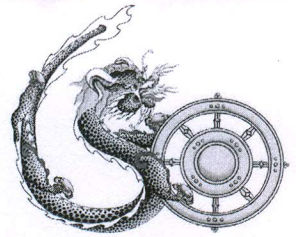

NOTIFICATION

The Department of National Properties, Ministry of Finance would like to remind all the procuring agencies that in order for any supplier, contractor or service provider who has or is likely to suffer, loss or injury resulting from an alleged breach of the Procurement Rules & Regulations (2009) is entitled to seek review by submitting a written complaint to the head of procuring agency responsible for such procedure ***the issuance of letter of intent to award the contract*** was made mandatory from 1st July 2015.

However, it is noticed that some agencies are still using the old standarding bidding document which don't have the provision for letter of intent.

Therefore, all agencies are reminded to use the updated standard bidding documents available in Public Procurement Policy Division website address www.pppd.gov.bt and issue letter of intent to award to enable the aggrieved bidders to make complaint in writing to the Procuring agency within ten (10) days from the date of letter of intent to award the contract.
