NOTIFICATION

The Ministry of Finance has formally launched *electronic* Daily Allowance & Travel System (*eDATS*) for implementation in all government budgetary bodies from July 2021 (FY2021-22).

The *eDATS* will be used for processing any in-country travel allowance (TA), daily allowance (DA) and daily subsistence allowance (DSA) for all public servants in the government budgetary bodies.

With the implementation of *eDATS*, use of manual forms will be discontinued. The submission and approval of travel claims shall be processed through this system and the payments shall be disbursed through *e-PEMS*.

In view of the above, all budgetary bodies shall use *eDATS* with effect from 1st July, 2021. Any technical support required will be rendered by the Department of Public Accounts, Ministry of Finance.
