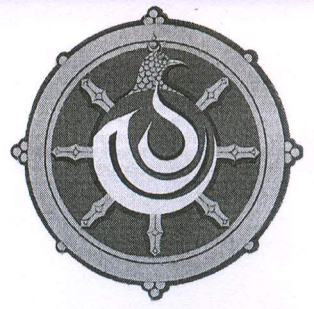

NOTIFICATION

In keeping with the directive received from the Cabinet Secretariat vide letter No.C-3/03/2021/1081 dated October 1, 2021 the Ministry of Finance amends Section 6 of the Notification No.DRC/TAX/M&E/Notification-01/2020/2553 dated 29th June, 2020 by lifting the moratorium on the import of import of Electric and Hybrid vehicles costing above USD40,000/- with effect from 20th October 2021.

This is to promote private businesses particularly vehicle dealers to revive the economy.

However, as the pandemic is still evolving, the moratorium on the import of fossil fuel vehicles and bikes costing more than USD40,000 and USD10,000 respectively will continue to hold till further directives.
