NOTIFICATION

Subject: Amendment to the Vehicle Import Quota Rules 2019

This is to notify that an amendment to the Vehicle Import Quota Rules 2019 is made in keeping with the macroeconomic situation in the country.

As per Section 12 of the Vehicle Import Quota Rules 2019, the validity of the vehicle import quota shall be for 7 (seven) years from the date of issue of allotment letter issued by the MoF or one year from the date of separation from service.

Section 12 of the Vehicle Import Rules 2019 is hereby amended as follows:

The validity of the vehicle import quota shall be for 7 (seven) years from the date of issue of allotment letter issued by the MoF or one year from the date of separation from service. The validity of the vehicle import quota can be renewed with the MoF within the period of seven years or one year time frame before the expiry. If the validity period has lapsed before the renewal, MoF shall not renew the vehicle import quota.

The vehicle import quota usage affected by the Notification No.MoF/PPD/Notification/40(1)/309 dated 18th August, 2022 regarding the Moratorium on the Import of Vehicles shall be reviewed by the Ministry of Finance on a case by case basis.
